Dear AmeriHealth Caritas Pennsylvania and AmeriHealth Caritas Northeast Primary Care Providers:

Effective November 12, 2015, our Intensive Case Management (ICM) reimbursement program will offer an additional payment to primary care physicians delivering care to chronically ill patients. We are offering this opportunity for additional payment to ensure that the most up-to-date and accurate reflection of disease acuity within our membership is recorded and submitted to the Department of Human Services (DHS).

Currently, providers can be reimbursed every 180 days for the submission of one initial claim or adjusted claims indicating chronic and comorbid conditions based on the Chronic Illness and Disability System (CDPS) by billing procedure code 99499.

With the program enhancement, you may be asked to review multiple dates of service occurring between the 180 day span, at which time an additional \$7.00 reimbursement will be available by billing procedure code 99499.

Sample:

The ICM payment enhancement will be available for the current risk adjusted rate cycle (2016b), which includes dates of service from December 1, 2014 through November 30, 2015. The NaviNet ICM application is being updated to provide your office with all the claims available for review and adjustment with dates of service during the current risk period. This update will allow you to review only the medical record corresponding to the requested date of service on the ICM claim and to submit for reimbursement, rather than reviewing all other dates of service.
